

INSIDE DRIVER SIDE ROCKER PANE

Step by Step Installation Instructions

- STEP 1: Read and understand instructions completely before beginning installation. Remove all old steps and hardware from truck.
- STEP 2: Locate the driver's side step (the notched end of the Magnum RT Steps goes to the front of the vehicle). See Fig A.
- STEP 3: The mounting brackets are the same for both driver and passenger sides, except the rear bracket RTSPN052. Locate (3) RTSPN043 and 1 RTSPN052 mounting brackets to be used on the driver side. Looking underneath the truck at the driver side inside rocker panel there are 8 black, plastic plugs along the length of the cab. Next to the black plastic plugs are smaller holes. Remove the 8 plugs and insert provided U-Nuts. Do the same for the holes directly below those in the rocker panel. See (FIG B).

- STEP 4: Once the U-Nuts have been installed, loosely fit RTSPN043 brackets to inside rocker panel with provided hardware (See FIG B). Do not fully tighten. There is a 3rd hole at the rear of the cab towards the front from the rear most holes in the rocker panel. This 3rd hole is for the provided T-Bolt used to mount the rear bracket RTSPN052. Insert the T-bolt into the hole and use provided plastic square nut to keep the T-bolt from falling into the hole. Loose fit the rear bracket RTSPN052 to the T-bolt and U-nuts, do not fully tighten. (FIG C)
- STEP 5: Once brackets are fitted, loose fit Magnum RT Steps using provided hardware (Fig D). Once Magnum RT Steps are loose fit, tighten brackets to inside rocker (DO NOT USE IMPACT TOOLS). Next, adjust bar up/down and front/back then tighten step to brackets
- STEP 6: Repeat for passenger side.
